## TUITION COSTS

**Basic Tuition for 2008-2009                    \$3900**

## DISCOUNTS

- \$600 Association Discount—discount for members of association congregations (*association membership based on confirmation from the pastor of that congregation*)
- 10% discount for members of supporting congregations (*supporting congregation membership based on confirmation from the pastor of that congregation*)
- 20% discount for additional children
- 25% discount for children of Called church workers of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod
- 5% discount if tuition is paid-in-full by Aug. 15

*Tuition for families receiving multiple discounts will be figured by subtracting a discount, setting a new rate, and subtracting the next discount. This discounts are listed above in order.*

## FEES

There is a \$200 application/registration fee for all new students. This fee is non-refundable unless the application is denied. Returning students will be assessed a \$50 re-registration fee. There is a \$100 fee for enrollment in the Driver's Education program. No other required fees exist.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

- A) Pay-in-full by August 15
- B) Monthly payments—payments due on 15<sup>th</sup> of the month and the last tuition payment must be made by May.
- C) Two payments (by August 15 and January 15)

## TUITION ASSISTANCE

We seek to make it possible for all interested families to select CORLHS to educate their children. Therefore, we have established a tuition assistance program. All CORLHS families are eligible to apply. Tuition assistance is awarded based on demonstrated financial need. Application for enrollment to CORLHS must be made before a tuition assistance application will be considered by the Tuition Assistance Committee. ## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- A) The basic tuition rate for the student's first year of enrollment is the rate that is "locked in" for the rest of that student's education at CORLHS. Tuition may rise on an annual basis, but not for returning students.
- B) Tuition will be paid according to the predetermined plan as agreed to by the parent/guardian. Any exception to one of the payment options must be requested in writing and approved by the principal.
- C) There is a \$20 fee for payments that are more than 15 days late and a \$20 fee for each additional 15 days late.
- D) Checks returned to CORLHS from a bank because of insufficient funds will result in a fee of \$25.
- E) Services may be suspended or re-enrollment denied if tuition payments are not kept current.
- F) Enrollment at CORLHS for any portion of a quarter (grading period) constitutes a quarter of tuition.
- G) CORLHS recognizes that occasionally circumstances make it impossible to make payments on a schedule. At such a time, please contact the principal to discuss options. CORLHS seeks to work with families in a proactive manner when financial situations arise.
