### Snow Days

While we want students in school, it is more important that they be safe.

### Junior Senior Prom

The growth of our student body is indeed a blessing but with such growth often comes necessary changes. Beginning this year, our spring formal dance becomes the Junior/Senior Prom. This year, and this year only, the sophomore class will be allowed to attend, since they were able to do so last year. The prom is open only to junior's and seniors (and sophomores this year) and their dates, as will

the Post-Prom event that follows at the school. Also this year, no dinner will be served, due to the expense and lack of interest from the upperclassmen. This will help reduce ticket prices significantly. Ticket prices have been tentatively set at \$12 for individual, \$20 for couples.

Lunch Accounts: Students and their families are encouraged to keep pace with lunch accounts. For practical reasons, the school cannot allow unpaid balances to accumulate. Any student who exceeds \$250 in unpaid lunches will not be allowed to order further lunches until the balance is paid down.

### Scholastic Bowl Team

The Silver Stallions scholastic bowl team will hold practice after school on Tuesday, Jan. 10 and will travel to Ramsey on Thursday, Jan. 12 for a tri-meet beginning at 6:30 p.m. We will leave the school grounds at 5 p.m. The varsity

squad is currently ranked third overall (5-2) in conference, following the fall matches. Senior Quinn DeBernardi is fifth in individual conference play with 13 correct tossups. Junior varsity is ranked fourth overall (4-3) with sophomore Celia Belli tied for third place in individual scoring, with 20 correct toss ups answered in the fall round of play.

### **SLT Concessions**

Concessions are open for the benefit of the student body beginning at 7:30 to 7:50 a.m. in the mornings before school, and after school to at least 3:30 p.m. Please note that only Student Leadership Team officers or other approved workers are allowed to open the concessions and operate or supervise their operation. Students are not permitted to help themselves to sodas or other items and mark the sheets. This must be done only by SLT or approved helpers. Also, beginning Monday, Jan. 9, soda will not be sold during morning concessions.
