Part-Time Student Program – to serve Home-Schooled Families

Centralia, IL.... Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School is implementing a program that seeks to serve home school families. The purpose of this program is to serve families who home-school students in grades 9-12, providing them with educational and extra-curricular opportunities that are sometimes difficult to provide in the home.

Through this program, families can register a student for one to five classes. These students will be classified as part-time students. The idea is to offer opportunities for home-schooled students to enroll in science, math, or other classes that involve hands-on experiences or require a great deal of expertise to effectively teach. “We recognize that more and more families are home-schooling their children, even into the high school years. We want to offer services to help facilitate the home-schooling process,” stated CORLHS Principal Curtis Wudtke. “We are proud of the quality education that we offer at Christ Our Rock and feel that this is another way in which we can serve people in our community.”

Part-time students will be evaluated and grades assigned according to the normal standards of CORLHS. Credits will also be awarded for successful completion of each class. Students enrolled in this program also gain access through Christ Our Rock to other educational resources and support from the CORLHS faculty and staff. Standardized testing services, college counseling, and scholarship information are all included.

As CORLHS has an eight period day, families of part-time students will pay 1/8 of the basic CORLHS tuition for each class in which they are enrolled. Each new student must complete an application process before they can enroll. That process includes a one-time application fee.

Any part-time student may participate in any extra-curricular that CORLHS provides, if he/she meets the criteria for that program and all applicable rules from IHSA or other pertinent organizations. Part-time students are invited to attend and participate in all social and academic functions of CORLHS.
