

Are your children provided for in the event of your death?

Do you have a will, a durable power of attorney for health care and another one for financial matters? Have you named guardians for your children should you die? Are you happy with your current plans? These are questions which none of us like to think about. But taking care of these matters is part of being a responsible steward of the blessings with which God has entrusted you.

Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School invites families to create their Lifetime Plan for Giving by attending three estate planning sessions. This is a free service provided by CORLHS to assist our families in accomplishing essential planning. You will be walked through the process of setting up a will, trust, or other documents to ensure your children are cared for and your wishes fulfilled. This is very important for all families. Even small estates should have these documents prepared or the State of Illinois will decide what happens to your children and assets, not you. We don't plan to die but what happens if we do?

Here's how it will work:

- Attend three sessions held in the Media Center at CORLHS on the Tuesday evenings of January 31, February 28, and March 27 from 7-8:15 p.m. The sessions will be led by Kirk Mueller from the LCMS Foundation and Chad Knolhoff, CORLHS Associate Gift Planning Counselor. If you cannot attend these sessions, contact Chad to setup individual appointments.
- Participants will be able to create a will, minor's trust, guardians for their children, durable power of attorney for health care and durable power of attorney for financial matters for themselves.
- Participants will ensure care for their children and blessings for their favorite ministries in the event of their untimely death.
- There is no cost for establishing your Lifetime Plan for Giving. The only cost to participants will be those incurred when the attorney drafts the necessary legal documents. We have made arrangements with several local attorneys who have agreed to draft the above referenced documents for a very reasonable cost.
